- V. Town Manager's Report
 1. Both trash trucks have been received, insured, and registered. Training is on-going and these vehicles will become a familiar sight to many shortly.
 2. Contracts for the changeover of street lighting have been received, are under legal review. We expect work to commence in May for the change over to the new lighting system.

3. The contract for the revaluation of the Town has been awarded to the low bidder Municipal Resources. Work will commence after review and approval by the State Department of Revenue Administration.
4. The engineering work for the replacement of the Park Avenue culverts is underway. The Department of Public Works plans to complete the engineering, obtain the necessary permits and complete construction during the coming summer
5. Work orders for the electronic inside door at the Town Office is in the works and we expect the unit to be installed during the coming summer.
6. Applications for veteran's, elderly, blind, and other tax credits, as well as the Hampton Beach Precinct entertainment tax exemption are due to be filed by April 15, 2019. Please see the Assessor's office for the necessary forms.
