1. Town Attorney Mark Gearreald asked the Board to go into Non-Public Session, under RSA 91-A:3,II,(e) Litigation.

At 5:00 PM, Selectman Bridle MOVED to go into Non-Public Session, under RSA 91-A:3,II,(e) [Litigation], SECONDED by Selectman Woolsey, which was voted unanimously by ROLL CALL (5-0-0).

[The Minutes were sealed by vote following the resumption of the public session]

At 5:02 PM, a MOTION was made by Selectman Bridle , SECONDED by Selectman Barnes, to leave the non-public session, which was approved unanimously (5-0).

At approximately 5:03 PM, back in public session, Selectman Bridle MOTIONED, SECONDED by Selectman Barnes, to seal the minutes of the non-public session on the basis that disclosure of the minutes could jeopardize the actions to be taken, which was passed by a roll call vote of 5-0.

2. Petitioned Warrant Articles

Town Manager Welch notified the Board that no new petitioned articles were received by the 5:00 PM end of the business day; therefore, no further discussion or votes on petitioned articles needed to be taken at this time. Town Manager Welch noted that new petitioned articles could be received by individual Selectmen if received by midnight today.

At 9:04 PM, the Selectmen adjourned the Public Session on MOTION of Selectman Bridle, SECONDED by Selectman Waddell, which passed unanimously (5-0).
