At approximately 9:11 PM, on MOTION made by Selectman Woolsey, SECONDED by Vice Chairman Barnes, the Board voted unanimously by roll call (5-0) to go into a non-public session under RSA 91-A:3,II, (c) [reputation].

Also present: Town Manager Welch; Town Attorney Gearreald.

Assessing Department issues: It was discussed that there are a large number of pick-ups needing to be processed, which need to be completed before April 1, 2019. Discussion was had about the length of time these have been pending and why. The Town Manager is to get figures as to the cost of having MRI complete this work in time.

The day-to-day operations of the Assessing Department were discussed and how best to carry these out under the new contract assessor regime.

On MOTION of Chairman Bridle, SECONDED by Selectman Griffin, the Board voted unanimously (5-0) to have the Board of Selectmen maintain oversight over the Assessing Department as they are the assessors by statute, but that the day-to-day operations of the Assessing Department shall now be supervised by the Town Manager and the Deputy Town Manager.

A MOTION was made by Selectman Waddell, SECONDED by Vice-chairman Barnes to leave the non-public session adjourn at 9:23 PM, which was approved unanimously (5-0).

The rejoined public meeting adjourned at 9:24 PM on MOTION by Selectman Waddell, SECONDED by Vice-chairman Barnes, which passed unanimously (5-0).
