**I. Call to order**

**V. Group discussion**

Mr. Jerry Znoj brought the Town Ordinance code of ethics 594-3b, 594-5-1a and 594-C to the Committee's attention and stated that every member should be familiar with it. Mr. Jamie Sullivan stated that Mr. Mark Gearreald, Town Attorney had reviewed the code in regard to the members when the Committee was implemented and referred the Committee to code 594-7.

The Committee members each spoke to the group regarding issues for the Committee to consider. The main items discussed were as follows:

- Board of Selectmen instructions to the Committee
- The effects of Covid 19 on local businesses and Town operations
- Consideration of grandfathering collection service for those who currently receive it
- Coordination with the Planning Board regarding trash collection for future developments
- Recycling glass and cardboard to reduce tonnage expense and increase revenue
- Reducing recycling contamination
- Reducing glass use at the beach
- Hauling and tipping fees
- Hampton's relationship with the State of NH in regard to trash collection
- The number of carts allowed and charging for additional carts
- Composting
- Public education in regard to trash collection and recycling
- Consideration creating sub-committees within the Solid Waste Committee
