Re: Service Federal Credit Union Robbery

HAMPTON, NH- The Hampton Police Department, in conjunction with the Federal Bureau of Investigation has arrested and charged a Manchester, NH man for Robbery stemming from an incident at the Service Federal Credit Union on Lafayette Road in Hampton.

On April 4, 2022 at approximately 2:41pm, the Hampton Police Department, along with the FBI, took into custody:

**Eric Mohan, 47
Manchester, NH**

Mohan was taken into custody in front of the Service Federal Credit Union after committing the crime and charged with a felony level offense for Robbery. He is being held on preventative detention and is scheduled to be arraigned at the Rockingham County Superior Court on April 5, 2022 at 1:00pm.

There were no injuries during the arrest. All further media inquiries should be made to the FBI's Boston Field Office.
