Re: Arrest of Wondens Valmont

**HAMPTON, NH-** The Hampton Police Department has arrested and charged a Keene, NH man with Felony Domestic Violence, Criminal Threatening after an incident that occurred in Hampton on May 10, 2023.

On May 10, 2023 at approximately 9:15pm, the Hampton Police Department received a call from staff at the Mount Prospect Academy facility alleging that a female staff member was being threatened by her boyfriend. The boyfriend was identified as WONDENS VALMONT, 22. Mr. Valmont has a Keene, NH address but was also alleged to have been staying with his girlfriend in Hampton.

It was reported to police that Mr. Valmont had allegedly been making threats against his girlfriend which included various alleged threats regarding the use of a firearm. Through the investigation, officers determined that Mr. Valmont was on his way to the Mount Prospect Academy address and that he most likely had a firearm in his possession. Officers formed a perimeter and were able to make contact with Mr. Valmont in the area of Lafayette Road in Hampton within close proximity to the facility at approximately 9:50pm. Officers closed in on Mr. Valmont and took him into custody without further incident.

Officers found Mr. Valmont in possession of a firearm and ammunition. After further interviews, investigation, and collection of evidence, officers determined that there was probable cause to charge Mr. Valmont with a Class A Felony offense of Domestic Violence (Criminal Threatening with a Deadly Weapon).

Mr. Valmont was transported to the Hampton Police Department and was ordered held on preventative detention by a bail commissioner. He is scheduled to be arraigned at the Rockingham County Superior Court on May 11, 2023 at 1:00pm.

There were no injuries in this incident and no known property damage. This case continues to be investigated and as such, limited information is being released at this time. Further charges may be forthcoming.
