

HELP THE TOWN OF HAMPTON RECYCLE RIGHT

The primary source of contamination is plastic garbage bags. While some people will use a plastic bag to collect their recycling in the home, **prior to placing them into the Town bin**, the contents need to be emptied into the recycling cart without the bag.





Let's get back to the basics of recycling.

Remember these three rules each time you recycle:



Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.



Keep food and liquids out of the recycling.



Empty recyclables directly into your cart - NO bagged recyclables.

RECYCLING RULES

1. Recycle all bottles, & containers cans and paper
2. Keep items CLEAN & DRY
3. **NO plastic bags**
