HELP THE TOWN OF HAMPTON RECYCLE RIGHT

The primary source of contamination is plastic garbage bags. While some people will use a plastic bag to collect their recycling in the home, prior to placing them into the Town bin, the contents need to emptied into the recycling cart without the bag.







Let's get back to the basics of recycling.

Remember these three rules each time you recycle:



Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.



Keep food and liquids out of the recycling.





Empty recyclables directly into your cart - NO bagged recyclables.
